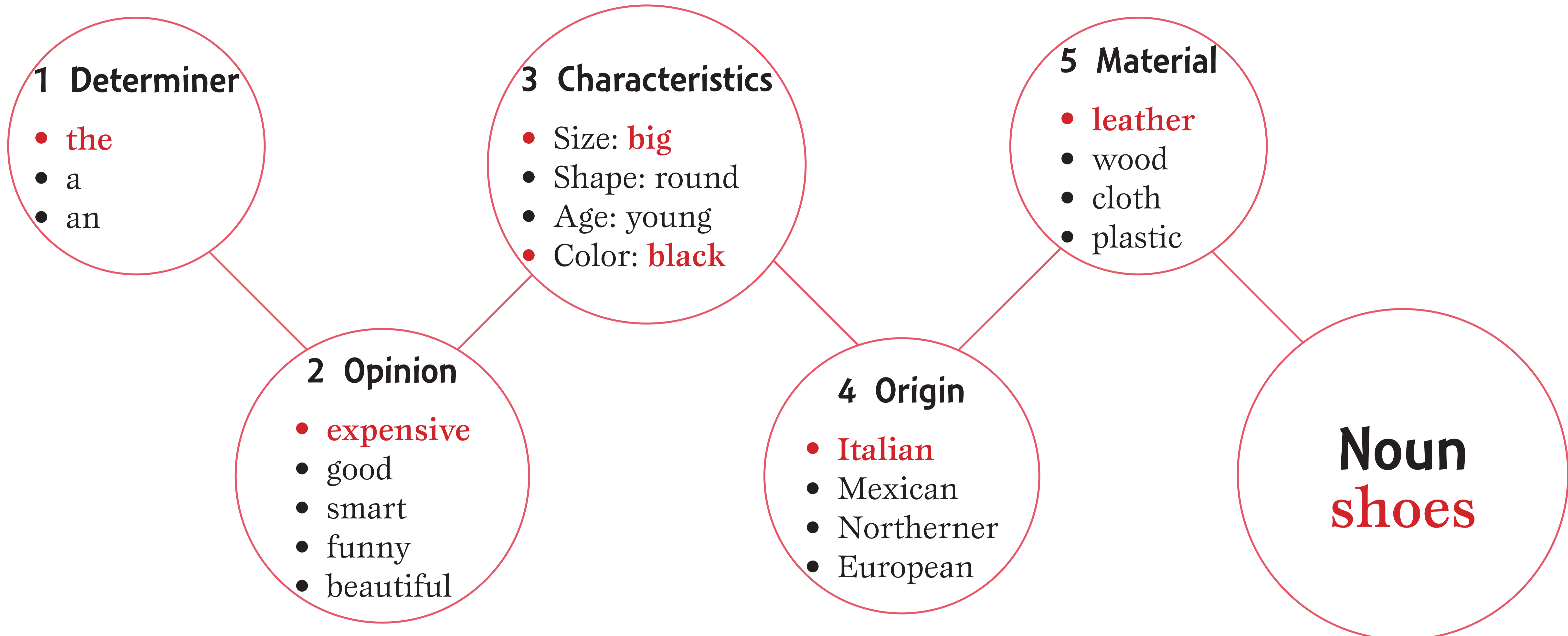


DESCRIPTIVE ADJECTIVES

Which	gives information about things	The Taj Mahal is the Indian mausoleum which looks like a palace.	The Taj Mahal, which is in India, holds the tomb of the Mughal emperor Shah Jahan.
Where	gives information about places	New York is the city where you can find the most famous musicals.	We saw <i>The Lion King</i> in New York City, where the most famous musicals are shown.
Who	gives information about people	Ada Lovelace was the woman who wrote the first computer algorithm.	Ada Lovelace, who was a countess, is considered to be the first computer programmer.
That	gives information about things or people	Marie Curie made the discovery that allowed scientists to know about radiation.	My project for English class, that I presented yesterday, was about Marie Curie.

Relative pronouns are used to introduce relative clauses which give more information about things, places, or people. Sometimes the information they give is vital to understand the whole idea, but sometimes is just additional information. When the information they give is additional, use commas.
